



Report from the Annual Assembly of NAITM

Date: 15 January 2026

Venue: Hotel Arka, Skopje

On 15 January 2026, the regular Annual Assembly of the National Association for Incoming Tourism of Macedonia (NAITM) was held at Hotel Arka in Skopje. The members of the Association unanimously adopted a number of important decisions that define the direction of work for the upcoming period.

Adopted Reports and Work Programme

The Assembly reviewed and adopted the Activity Report for 2025, which includes the successful implementation of several significant projects. Among them are the Green Spirit Prespa project, the SIPPO/IME programme, the organization of roadshow events in Denmark and Sweden within the Reconomy project, as well as the enhanced cooperation with Turkish Airlines.

The Financial Report for 2025 was also adopted. The Association's revenues during the past year derived from annual membership fees paid by members and from project implementation.

The members unanimously supported the Work Programme for 2026, which focuses on several priority areas. The final phase of implementation of the Green Spirit Prespa project is currently underway, while in parallel the activities of the Reconomy project will be implemented, including roadshow events in Oslo and Helsinki and the organization of FAM trips for international tour operators.

The Association will continue strengthening the digital capacities of its members through the SIPPO programme. Special emphasis will be placed on expanding the membership and improving internal communication. In order to enable more active involvement of members in the work of the Association, three working groups have been established by key tourism segments: accommodation, active tourism, and eno-gastro tourism.



Election of the Management

The Assembly confirmed Vlatko Sulev as President of the Association, with a mandate until December 2026. Dimitar Gjorgievski and Simona Dimovska were elected as Vice Presidents, while Simona Dimovska and Martin Jakimovski were elected as new members of the Executive Board.

New Membership

The Assembly unanimously admitted Quendoo MK as a Premium Member of NAITM. Quendoo MK is a platform for the digitalization of tourism services, and its membership will contribute to further strengthening the digital capacities of the Association and its members.

Amendments to the Statute

The members adopted several important amendments to the Statute of the Association. The amendments include the introduction of the function of two Vice Presidents, clarification of the competences of the governing bodies of the Association, as well as provisions on incompatibility of functions and freezing of membership for persons holding executive government positions, with the aim of preventing conflicts of interest.

Conclusion

The Annual Assembly of NAITM laid solid foundations for the work in the upcoming period. The adopted decisions are aimed at strengthening the capacities of the Association, expanding the membership base, increasing transparency in operations and intensifying activities for the promotion of incoming tourism in the Republic of N.Macedonia.
